
Mullen's and Baker dominate NSGA Junior Boys & Girls Championship

It was a perfect week at the Digby Pines Golf Resort & Spa for the 2021 Halifax Jaguar Land Rover Boys & Girls Provincial Championships, which took place from July 6-8.

The host club and local volunteers did a fantastic job welcoming the 105 competitors to the little town of Digby, Nova Scotia.



The Pee-Wee and Bantam titles were crowned after round two of the Championships. The Boys Pee-Wee division saw a record of 15 participants.

Kooper MacKay, of KenWo Golf Club, took home top prize in the Boys U13 division, after firing a two day total of 73-76--149. On the girls side, Tatum Lohnes of Osprey Ridge claimed top spot after carding a two day score of 98-98--196.




For the U15 division, Elliott Mullen of Truro Golf Club took home the title over fellow Truro member Zach Gaudet. Mullen carded a two day total of 76-79--155.

Olivia Seaman of KenWo Golf Club and Annika Parkash of Ashburn were tied after two rounds for the U15 girls title, with a score 176. Seaman claimed the title after winning in a one-hole playoff.

The top twelve U15 boys and girls qualified for the final round of the championship.

Truro Golf Club team, comprised of the three Mullen brothers took home the NEW Club Team Competition.



The final round of the championship would determine the top players for both boys and girls U17 and U19 divisions.

Abbey Baker took home the U17 and U19 girls titles after carding a tournament total of 78-79-80--237. Ten shots ahead of 2nd place, Abbey Wamboldt of Northumberland Links. Who had a three day total of 247. Emma Rushton of KenWo rounded out the top three, with a final score of 254.


Baker, Wamboldt and Rushton will represent Team Nova Scotia at the Junior Girls Nationals taking place from July 20-23, at the [Leduc Golf & Country Club](#) in Leduc Alberta.

On the boys side, Elliott Mullen claimed top spot in the U17 division, narrowly beating out older brother Simon Mullen by three shots. The eldest Mullen brother, and Team Canada member, Owen Mullen fired an impressive tournament score of even par, 72-69-72--213.

Owen Canavan of Ashburn Golf Club took home second place after carding a comeback 2-under, 69 in the final round. Canavan finished the tournament with a total of 222. Jake Smith and Dimitri Mihelakos, both of Ashburn Golf Club, finished tied for third, one shot back from Canavan. The pair forced a playoff to determine the final spot to represent Team NS at the Junior Boys Nationals.

Smith came out victorious, and will join Mullen and Canavan at nationals taking place at [Vallee Du Richelieu \(Club de Golf\)](#) in Sainte-Julie, Quebec from August 9-12, 2021.
