Rules of Golf (effective January 2023) and, the Golf Nova Scotia 2025 Local Rules and Terms of the Competition, these Supplementary Local Rules.

Governing play. NOTE: Local rules published by the Host Club DO NOT apply. The penalty for breaching a Local Rule is **2 strokes** in Stroke Play and may result in disqualification for any subsequent offence.

Golf NS Code of Conduct applies. Any conduct considered detrimental to the best interests of the game, or unbecoming a competitor, either on or off the course, and coming to the attention of the Tournament Committee, will be strictly dealt with and may result in disqualification of the offending person(s).

Tees: The **MID-AMATEUR** championship will be contested from the Golf Nova Scotia **White** tees.

Forecaddies: Positioned on Holes #4, #10, #12 and #17 for safety only - **PLEASE HEED THEIR SIGNALS**

Course Yardage Markers: Markers to the green centre at 150 yards (white), and 100 yards (red).

Designated Practice Areas: Practice putting green and the practice range. See Golf Nova Scotia 2025 Local Rules & Terms of the Competition.

Out Of Bounds: Is located on the right side of #1, #2, #3, #4 #14 and #18, behind the green #9 and #18. The out of bounds are defined by the mowed area of the course where white stakes are present, by a white painted line or a fence (#2 & #3).

Lateral and Crossing Penalty Areas: All Penalty areas are RED PENALTY AREAS. Left side of #10 & #12. Right side of #1 green, #8, #13, and in front of #11 tee. All drainage ditches, marked or unmarked, with or without water, are Penalty Areas.

No Play Zones: The area defined by the netted area on #3 fairway is a no-play zone and is treated as an abnormal course condition. Relief **must be taken** from interference by the No Play Zone under Rule 16.1f. (MLR E-8.1)

Drop Zones: If a player's ball is in the Ground Under or No Play Zones including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the GUR or NPZ, the player has these relief options 1) take relief under 16.1 or 2) by dropping in the nearest drop zone no closer to the hole. Drop zones #3 fairway.

Abnormal Course Conditions: See Golf Nova Scotia Local Rules & Terms of the Competition. Worn-out areas adjacent to or on extension to cart paths are considered an extension of the cart path.

Immovable Obstructions: Players are entitled to relief under **Rule 16.1**. Irrigation controls are located behind #2 green and the pumphouse on #11.

Power lines: If a ball hits a power line, the shot must be replayed.

Breaking Ties: Playoff Format: If a playoff is necessary to determine the Championship, a Provincial Team position or a quota position for the Canadian Mid-Amateur, the playoff will follow a sudden victory hole-by-hole format, starting on the 2nd and 5th holes, repeated as needed until a winner is declared.
