

GOLF NOVA SCOTIA PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIPS TROPHY POLICY

Final Jan 2026

This policy outlines the guidelines for handling and retaining trophies for tournaments organized by Golf Nova Scotia. It ensures fairness, consistency, and respect for the symbolic value of trophies.

Golf Nova Scotia awards perpetual trophies that remain the property of the organization and are passed annually to winners.

Trophies are presented during the official closing ceremony of our Provincial Championship. The tournament director or staff will ensure the occasion is documented with the winner and the trophy.

Care of Trophies

Trophies are to be presented to winners in a polished state. The use of soft cloths and silver polish is required. Staff and volunteers are expected to transport and treat the trophies with respect. Trophies should be secured for transport to each tournament.

Trophy Return and Responsibility

Perpetual Trophies must be returned in good condition 30 days after the event concludes.

Winners are responsible for any damage or loss when the trophy is in their possession.

Engraving & Personalization

Golf Nova Scotia will handle the engraving of names, dates, and titles. No unauthorized modifications or additions are allowed.

Trophies will be sent to be engraved by the end of each season to ensure they are ready for the upcoming season.
