



Team PEI will look to defend their title when the **2026 Maritime Cup** is played **Friday June 12 - Sunday June 14** at the **Amherst Golf Club**.

***Format:***

The format is Solheim Cup style match play. Each person will play **2 matches on Saturday** with a partner. Four Ball (Best Ball) in the morning and then Foursomes (Alternate Shot) in the afternoon. Sunday will be singles. Mandatory carts are included for the tournament rounds. A practice round is also included that you may play at any point between when the club opens and the event.

***Team Composition:***

Each Maritime province (NB, NS, PEI) will send a team of 12 players.

If you live in one province and your home club is in another province, you will play for the province where your home club is located. All players must have a current Golf Canada Handicap Index.

Each team will be comprised of women with a range of ages (19+) and handicap indexes.

At a prior year's event each team included: 4 Players:0-9.9, 3 Players:10-17.9, 3 Players:18-24.9, and 2 Players:25+. Once entries are received, we will review the entries to determine the exact handicap ranges for this year. We want to ensure all handicaps have as equal an opportunity to participate as possible.

If any handicap range is oversubscribed, we will do a 'Live' draw (online) on Wednesday April 23 at 7pm. A random picker will be used to select participants. You are welcomed to watch the draw if you wish but you are not required to be present to be selected.

***Pricing:***

Pricing is confirmed at **\$340 per person** (taxes in).

The package price includes:

- 4 rounds of golf (practice round + 3 tourney rounds),
- Shared cart for the 3 tourney rounds,
- Range balls on Saturday and Sunday,
- Friday night appetizers during the "Pairings Party",
- Saturday: lunch, and evening meal.

Accommodations are **not** included in the package pricing. We have secured a block of rooms (breakfast included) at the Comfort Inn Amherst at a cost of \$160/night + taxes. When the teams are confirmed, we will send you the information to book a room in the block if you wish. **Please do not call the hotel to book yet.**

***Registration:***

“Registration” will open on April 7 at 8am and close on April 14 at noon. Please note that **registering does not confirm your place in the event.**

To register please go to this link <https://forms.gle/WCQRJnuLpqFUVWVRA> (the link will only work during the registration period). When you register you will receive a reply. If you do not receive a reply (please check your junk mail 😊) within 24 hours, that means you are not registered.

When registration closes, we will draw for any places that are oversubscribed and you will receive an email if selected.

Once you are selected to the team you will have 48 hours to confirm your place by sending a deposit of \$200 (details on where to send will be provided in the message confirming your selection). Please consider your deposit as non-refundable but know that if you are unable to attend, we will refund your deposit as soon as we are able to fill your spot. The remaining \$140 is due no later than May 13.

***Ongoing Communications:***

We will continue to communicate via the “Women’s Maritime Cup” Facebook page. It is a private group so you will have to answer a couple of very quick questions to join. Feel free to share the Facebook page with anyone who might be interested. If you have a golfing friend who might be interested and is not on Facebook, please share the registration details with them.
