**Rules of Golf** (effective January 2023), Golf Nova Scotia 2026 Local Rules and Terms of the Competition, and these Supplementary Local Rules.

**Governing play.** **NOTE: Local rules published by the Host Club DO NOT apply.** The penalty for breaching a Local Rule is 2 strokes in Stroke Play and may result in disqualification for any subsequent offence.

**Golf NS Code of Conduct** applies. Any conduct considered detrimental to the best interests of the game, or unbecoming a competitor, either on or off the course, and coming to the attention of the Tournament Committee, will be strictly dealt with and **may result in disqualification** of the offending person(s).

**Tees:** The championship will be contested from the Golf Nova Scotia **WHITE** tees.

**Forecaddies:** Positioned on Holes #2, #5 and #11. for safety only - **PLEASE HEED THEIR SIGNALS**

**Course Yardage Markers:** Markers to the green centre at 200 yards (**BLUE**), 150 yards (**WHITE**), and 100 yards (**RED**).

**Designated Practice Areas:** Practice putting green and practice range. See Golf Nova Scotia 2025 Local Rules & Terms of the Competition.

**Out of Bounds:** Defined by White stakes or lines on the left side of #9 and the right side of #17 and #18. OB extends to infinity.

**Lateral and Crossing Penalty Areas:** **All Penalty areas are RED PENALTY AREAS.**

**Faded red lines on the right of #5, the left of #6 and the left of #8 that are not marked with red stakes are not Penalty Areas.**

Penalty areas are located - #1 left side, #2 left side extending behind the green and pond in front of green, #3 left side, #4 brook crossing fairway and right side, #5 left side, #6 left and right, #8 left side, #10 left side, #12 Left and right side, #13 brook crossing and left and right sides, #14 brook crossing and left and right sides, #15 left and right sides and pond, #16 right side and #18 left side and pond right side near green. All drainage ditches, marked or unmarked, with or without water, are Penalty Areas.

**Note 1:** *When a lateral penalty area is defined on only one side, it is deemed to extend to infinity.*

**Environmental sensitive area** – The penalty area to the right of #15 green is an environmentally sensitive no-play zone. **DO NOT ENTER.** Penalty relief must be taken under Rule 17, or alternatively, the ball may be dropped in the drop zone.

**No Play Zones:** The areas defined by **BLUE** paint are no-play zones are treated as abnormal course conditions. Relief **must be taken** from interference by the No Play Zone under Rule 16.1f. (MLR E-8.1)

**Drop Zones:** If a player's ball is in the Ground Under or No Play Zones, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found is in the GUR or NPZ, the player has these relief options 1) take relief under 16.1 or 2) by dropping in the nearest drop zone no closer to the hole. Drop zones #15.

**Abnormal Course Conditions:** See Golf Nova Scotia Local Rules & Terms of the Competition. Worn-out areas adjacent to or on extension to cart paths are considered an extension of the cart path. Mulch beds under trees are GUR.

**Immovable Obstructions:** Players are entitled to relief under **Rule 16.1.** Memorial 100-yard stone markers, protective fencing around #14 tee, course washroom behind #16 green, pump house and storage shed on #18

**Breaking Ties** - Playoff Format: If a playoff is necessary to determine the Championship, a Provincial Team position or a Quota Position, the playoff will follow a sudden victory hole-by-hole format, starting on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> holes, repeated as needed until a winner is declared.
